**JOCKEY EDGAR PRADO, POISED TO FOIL BIG BROWN'S  
TRIPLE CROWN QUEST, SIGNS HIS BOOK ON BELOVED  
RACEHORSE, BARBARO, AT SPORTS MUSEUM OF AMERICA**

With horse racing's final race in the famed Triple Crown coming up next weekend, famed jockey Edgar Prado – riding Casino Drive, regarded as perhaps the only horse capable of denying Big Brown the first Triple Crown victory since 1978 – visits the Sports Museum of America ([www.sportsmuseum.com](http://www.sportsmuseum.com)) to sign his new book on America's favorite horse, Barbaro, on **Tuesday, June 3, 12:00 Noon, Sports Museum of America, 26 Broadway at Beaver Street, Lower Manhattan.**

With the Belmont Stakes only days away, Hall of Famer Prado skips the event's major press conference to greet fans and sign his book, MY GUY BARBARO (HarperCollins), at the nation's first ever museum dedicated to all sports.

Prado, who will ride the unbeaten Casino Drive against Big Brown in Saturday's Belmont Stakes, has ridden in more than 25,000 races, winning more than 6,000. He has twice before thwarted near Triple Crown quests (riding Savara in 2002 to defeat the favored War Emblem and guiding Birdstone in the 2004 upset over Smarty Jones).
